GREETINGS DEAR FRIENDS & FAMILY IN CHRIST!

Three months have passed so quickly since the fateful day of April 6th, when the island we now call home, was struck by a Category 5 Hurricane. The destruction and chaos was overwhelming afterwards, but we were also overwhelmed with the outpouring of support by so many from different parts of the world! The Body of Christ answered so generously to the need of the people of Vanuatu after the storm, and it was our joy and honor to be able to help so many families and to tell them that there are hundreds of people worldwide who gave towards their cause!

It's been a very busy time for our ministry here since the cyclone hit but it was always encouraging to know that while we were the feet on the ground there were so many standing behind us. So many people were praying for us, caring for us, and supporting us so we could run the ministry here and live up to its name: God will Provide!

With that motto in mind, we were praying, and the Lord opened many doors for us to give a helping hand, encouraging word & provide food, material for shelter, and tools for the needy. At times the need around us was too much to bear because there was lack of everything - wherever we went. So many homes

were destroyed, all gardens ruined, clinics and churches flattened. Nevertheless the people of Vanuatu showed incredible resilience and many are joining hands to help rebuild what is destroyed. We are already seeing how God in His faithfulness is working out this disaster for the good of His people here in Vanuatu.

Now that we are in the rebuilding phase, we were able to use the donations to buy food packages for many households and also provide assistance with different building materials and tools so that they could rebuild their homes and kitchens.



This relief work opened the way for us to serve in many new communities here in Espirito Santo and on the island of Malo. We were especially excited to be part of an aid project sponsored by Samaritan's Purse on the West Coast of Santo.

Since government restrictions have been lifted after the cyclone, we were able to be an encouragement to our neighborhood by hosting weekly prayer meetings and weekly children's programs.

NEW SEASON

We are praising God for two healthy babies that were born in the clinic since the cyclone! One was named Christian and the second Tueni, both after missionaries working in the area!



As of right now, it looks like Vanuatu will not open its borders until next year. Once the borders reopen, we are excited to be joined by missionaries once again. We also plan to host construction teams from USA, Europe and Australia who are wanting to help rebuild the clinic in Selel, schools, & churches that got destroyed.

Please continue keeping us in your prayers. That we would be enabled by the Holy Spirit to be faithful & bold witnesses in this new season. So that this ministry will glorify King Jesus & that many souls will be added to the Kingdom of God!
